Item 1

Dr Sunita Srivastava, Chairperson IQAC welcomed all the members to second IQAC meeting and informed about the various activities held between June 15 to September 21 in the institute. The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Director and confirmed



Director presented the status report till September 27, 2019 of all the NAAC Criteria Heads from 1 to 7. The work done so far was shown by the way of bar graphs in three colour zones – Green, Yellow and Red. Red represented data mostly unavailable, Yellow represents data in process and Green colour showed the data available.

Each Criteria Head presented their progress with respect to their criterion in each colour zone.

Criterion 4 did not have any red zone whereas Criterion 1 had highest red zone

It was suggested to each Criteria Head to be innovative with out of box thinking in filling the red/yellow gaps in their respective criterion.

Item 2

It was suggested to complete the feedback of all stakeholders in Criterion 1 and reduce the red zone to zero by the end of October. Suggestions should also be taken from Academic Advisory Committee members from time to time

Criterion 2 was suggested to reduce the yellow zone to nil

It was suggested to prepare a policy to recognize and reward faculty members for their contribution in research, publication and for receiving awards.

It was also suggested to prepare a usage report of the Library and explore the possibility of installing biometric for it. The possibility of installation of Solar Panels for compound lights is to be explored.

A list of all competitive exams taken by AIMSR students is to be prepared and support to be given to the students appearing in it.

All the classrooms should be converted to Smart Classrooms

A faculty training workshop is to be organized by inviting IQAC internal member of A++/A+ institution


An internal audit to be completed by the team between Nov 1 - 15, 2019.




